



SUBSIDIES FOR ACADEMIC MEETINGS

I. Conditions for granting a subsidy

- 1.1 The Institute of Missiology Missio gives subsidies for the organisation of scientific meetings etc., if they take place in a country in Asia, Africa, Oceania or Latin America.
- 1.2 The MWI also supports scholars from these continents who want to attend a meeting in Europe or North America.
- 1.3 The topic of the meeting, conference or general assembly has to be of importance for the theological or philosophical reflection on inculturation and contextuality.

II. Amount granted as subsidy

- 2.1 The subsidy partially or entirely meets the costs of the organisation of the conference or the travelling expenses of the participants.
- 2.2 The running costs of the institution responsible for the conference cannot be taken into consideration (secretary, salaries etc.).
- 2.3 A printing subsidy for the records of the meeting must be applied for separately.

III. Application procedure

- 3.1 The applicant should be a representative of the institution in charge of the realisation of the meeting. Applications from individual persons cannot be considered.
- 3.2 The application has to contain the following documents/information:
 - detailed programme with list of the lectures and lecturers
 - list of participants
 - place and exact date
 - tentative budget indicating all co-financing organisations

IV. Commitment of the organiser

- 4.1 Within three months after the conference, the organiser sends a report (including a financial report) to the MWI.
- 4.2 A complimentary copy of the records is sent to the MWI as soon as available.
